

Great Bradfords Junior School is a large, attractive primary school catering for children from 7 to 11 years of age. Currently, there are 340 pupils on roll. First opened in 1971, the buildings have been modernized over the years to provide a full range of facilities. These include a main hall, which is well equipped for physical education and is also used for assemblies, as well as before and after school activities, a newly refurbished computer suite, and a well stocked library. Our kitchen provides healthy school meals and the school operates a variety of after school clubs as well as a breakfast club.



Our well-equipped Computer Suite accommodates whole classes at a time. There are 32 touch screen computers for the children to use.

Our school is well resourced to deliver the National Curriculum. All children have access to a wide range of science and technology equipment and every classroom has an interactive whiteboard or interactive TV. The adjoining playing field accommodates football, rounders and athletics and an adventure trail. Two playgrounds provide opportunities for netball, short tennis and other games. Recent developments include an outdoor learning/wildlife area, including two ponds.

The children are mainly taught by their class teacher, who takes overall responsibility for promoting the child's progress and welfare. All classes have a designated learning assistant and there will be occasions when pupils will be taught by other teachers, who have appropriate subject expertise, e.g. for Music, French, Art and Religious Education.
